

General Practitioner means:

- (a) a medical practitioner registered with the New South Wales Medical Board;
- (b) whose practice involves the provision of primary, continuing and comprehensive whole-patient care to individuals, families and the community; and
- (c) who maintains a medical negligence insurance policy and/or contributes to a fund or belongs to an organisation which provides medical indemnity assistance to medical practitioners.

4.2.1 An Ordinary Member of the Company is a General Practitioner who practices in the Central Sydney GP Network as defined at the time of application and admission to Membership of the Company.

4.2.2 An Associate Member of the Company is:

- (a) a General Practitioner who practises in New South Wales but does not practice in the Central Sydney Network; and
- (b) any person, body corporate or other association whom the Directors in their discretion consider suitable for associate membership of the Company.
- (c) a GP Registrar who practices in the Central Sydney Network
